

Mull Hill race

THE ROUTE

The route will follow a circular (ish) course starting at Loch Na Keal heading over the summits of Beinn Ghraig, Beinn Fhada, A'Chioch, and Ben More then down the 'tourist' track to traverse back to the start.

SAFETY

All runners must carry full waterproof cover and map & compass. Each summit will be marshalled. Please understand that the route up A'Choich and up the Ben (same route as the Islands Peaks Race) is a Scottish 'classic' scramble and therefore is exposed on a number of sections. If you think that you would have a problem with rock scrambling then please don't enter the race. In clear conditions, the course gives superb views and excellent running. In mist, the course will require the ability to use map and compass effectively and to be confident on the hills in bad weather.

ENTRIES

Pre entry £5 or enter on the day £7. Junior & youth free.

JUNIOR & YOUTH RACE

The junior race will be 1.5 and the youth race 3 miles. Starting from the same start as the senior course, both courses will be out and back up the Beinn Fadda track.
